- Money market instruments

Money market instruments Liquid investments that pay interest and are designed to maintain a stable value.

Shares Securities that represent fractional ownership in a company. **Volatility** How sharply the Fund's share price has gone up and down over a period, generally several years.

You can buy, sell or switch units in the Fund on any business day, as defined within the "Definitions" Section of the Fund's prospectus.

The Fund offers accumulation units (units in which net income is retained within the price).

Risk and reward profile
